States to Australia! He was the first person to be inducted into both the Swimming Hall of Fame and the Surfing Hall of Fame.



Father Damien Statue STOP 7





The Father Damien statue is the centerpiece at the entrance of the Hawaii State Capitol. This landmark memorializes the famou's Hawai'i Catholic Church priest from Belgium who sacrificed his life for the lepers of the island of Moloka'i. Cast in bronze, Damien is depicted in his later years after being diagnosed himself with leprosy. In 2009, Pope Benedict XVI canonized Father Damien.

Dedicated in 1883, this was the second statue created after the ship delivering the original statue from Europe was lost at sea. The original statue was later found and erected


