Opening.	<p>Hello. How are you today? Good? Good.</p> <p>Look at the screen. This is ‘World Art Gallery’. Here are three paintings. ‘Still life with Basket and Six oranges.’, Maida Primavesi’, ‘Starry Night’.</p> <p>Let’s look at the first picture. Here are six oranges in the basket. What color can you see?</p> <p>Yes. It’s orange. What does the orange color remind you of? Yes, Minseo.</p> <p>It reminds you of summer.</p> <p>How about the third one, ‘Starry night’? This is night’s sky. What color can you see? Yes, Chae-won.</p>	<p>Orange</p> <p>Summer</p>	PPT.	5”

<p>Listen and choose.</p>	<p>Chae-won said blue color. What does blue color remind you of?</p> <p>The sea. The blue color reminds Chae-won of the sea.</p> <p>Colors remind us of different stories. Artists also tell stories through colors. Are you curious about their stories?</p> <p>Let's find out together.</p> <p>Let's look at our goal. Read together.</p> <p>We will listen to and read stories through colors. Later, you will create your own story through colors.</p> <p>Now, let's move on to Listen and Choose. Look at the screen. This is the boy, Junho, and the girl, Mina. Junho and Mina are visiting an art exhibition. They are looking at Picasso's painting, Woman with folded arms. While looking at Picasso's painting, they share their feelings through colors. Listen to the conversation and match the color with the feeling. Are you ready? Let's listen.</p> <p>Everyone, done? What color do they see?</p> <p>Yes, it's deep blue. What does the blue color remind Mina of?</p> <p>Yes, a blue color reminds Mina of a rainy day.</p>	<p>Blue</p> <p>The sea</p> <p>(Read together)</p> <p>It's deep blue.</p> <p>A rainy day.</p>	<p>PPT. <p>Reading.</p>	<p>How about Junho?</p> <p>Good. Blue colors remind Junho of Sadness.</p> <p>Now, we are going to read. Let's read the title together: "Colorful Stories of World Art".</p> <p>Good.</p> <p>This is about an Online Art Exhibition. There are four artists: Kim Whanki, Hokusai, Frida Kahlo, and Claude Monet.</p> <p>Artists from different countries tell stories through colors. Visitors look at paintings and leave comments about their feelings.</p> <p>While you read, find out the color and story of each artist. Please underline them. You have 5 minutes.</p>	<p>Sadness.</p> <p>(Read together)</p>	<p>PPT. Textbook.</p>	<p>10"</p>
<p>After reading.</p>	<p>Are you done? Now, let's complete the table: Stories through Colors.</p> <p>Artist, Country, Color, Story Write the color and the story of each artist. You have 3 minutes. Ready? Go.</p> <p>Everyone, finished? Let's find out together. Number 1. Monet's painting. What color does Monet use? Yes, Jihoo.</p> <p>It's Bright red. Good.</p> <p>What does bright red color remind Monet of?</p>	<p>It's Bright red.</p> <p>It reminds Monet of French autumn.</p>	<p>PPT. Textbook.</p>	<p>6"</p>

<p>Main activity.</p>	<p>Yes, the bright red color reminds Monet of French Autumn. Excellent.</p> <p>How about Kahlo? What color was used in Kahlo's painting?</p> <p>Good. It's bright colors. What does bright color remind Kahlo of?</p> <p>Right, bright color reminds her of Mexican culture and identity.</p> <p>Now, it's time to make your own Art Story. Before you make your own, let's read a sample together.</p> <p>This is our Art Story Card. You have two choices.</p> <p>Choose your favorite artwork or draw your own artwork.</p> <p>Think about your own story.</p> <p>Painting title, color, story, reason.</p> <p>You have 3 minutes. Everyone, done? Good.</p> <p>Do you want to see friends' paintings?</p> <p>Let's share our stories. Please post your own Art Story in Padlet. Look around at each other's stories. Choose one story and write one comment. For example, interesting story! I think so!
