Introduction of today's objectives	Last class, We learned about actions from the past to now. Then, Let's think about an everyday example. If you bought your phone two years ago, and you are still using it today, how can we say this? That's right! We can say, 'I have used this smartphone for two years. One more example. We started studying English in		

	<p>elementary school, and we are still studying it here in high school, right?</p> <p>So we can say, We? have studied English since elementary school. Good job!</p> <p>Today, we are going to read online posts from our global friends. They wrote about their own countries. And then, we are also going to write a post to introduce Korea to the world. Isn't it interesting?</p> <p>Then, Let's start today's lesson.</p>

Warm-up	<p>Before we meet our global friends, let's look at the screen. This is world map. There are so many countries with different climate. Let me ask you a question.</p> <p>Have you ever been to a very cold country? Raise your hand. Oh, Jihoon Where did you go? Sapporo, Wow! Jihoon has been to Sapporo. How was the weather there? Right! He experienced extreme cold.</p> <p>Okay, next question. Have you ever experienced a heavy rain during a trip? Yes, Sumin, Wow, you experienced heavy rain in Vietnam!</p>	PPT	

	<p>Anyone else? Oh Canada, Taiwan. Perfect. Our classmates have experienced so many different climates around the world!</p>		
<p>Before You Read A (Watch and Think)</p>	<p>Now, It's 'Watch and Think'. <부록 1 A 참고> Everyone, look at the screen. This is a house from another country.</p> <p>What is special about this? Right! The roof is very sharp and pointy. And what else? Yes, the floor is away from the ground. Good job.</p> <p>Then, what is the advantage of this house? Why did they build a house like this? Let's guess! Are you done?</p> <p>Okay Minho, That's right! When it rains, the water falls down fast from the roof.</p> <p>Then, Hana, what is good about the high floor? Yes! It blocks the hot air from the ground. Good idea! Does everyone agree? Good.</p>	<p>PPT Worksheet</p>	
<p>Before You Read B (Match and Guess)</p>	<p>Now, It's match and guess. <부록 1 B 참고> Look at the screen. Here are three friends. They are our global pen pals. And they posted a very popular challenge, 'What's in my bag?'.</p> <p>They are introducing special items in their bags. These items help them live with their country's weather. And there are hashtags that explain the weather of each country.</p>	<p>PPT Worksheet</p>	

	<p>Let's check together. Han lives in Mongolia. How is the weather in there? Yes. It's very cold.</p> <p>Next is Lucy. She lives in Peru. Peru has high mountains. How is the weather there? Are you confused? That's okay. No problem. I'll explain this. It is very hot in the day. But it is very cold at night. So the temperature is ups and downs.</p> <p>Finally, Leo lives in Malaysia. How about Malaysia? Yes. The sun is so strong like a sauna.</p> <p>Now, think about the weather of each country. Match each person with the right item and right hashtag. Then you have three minutes. Start.</p>		
Reading	<p>Now, let's read the posts from our friends Han, Lucy, and Leo. <부록 2 참고> Everyone, let's read the title together. 'What we wear, How we live.' Good.</p> <p>There are many pictures with posts. What kind of pictures do you see? Right! Pictures of clothes and houses. What else? Yes! There are fur clothes, mud house, and the high-floor house we just saw. Right?</p> <p>They posted these stories on a website 'Global Teen Link Board.' They are talking about how they live with their local climate.</p> <p>We are going to read three short posts today. And there are many actions from the past to now. We have been learning since last class. Right?</p>	PPT Worksheet	

	<p>So, underline these sentences while you read.</p> <p>After reading, talk with your partner. Check where you underlined, and find the important words about the weather. Okay? Then you have seven minutes. Read and talk. Start.</p> <p>Time's up. Are you done? Okay. Let's check our underlines together. First, in Han's post, where is the 'action from the past to now'? Let's answer together. Right! 'My family has lived in..'. Good! And next? Yes. 'We have built round tents..'. Good job. And the last one? Yes. 'We have worn...'. Perfect! Did you all find these three sentences? Okay.</p>		
<p>After You Read A (Read and Complete)</p>	<p>Now, look at the screen. It's 'Read and Complete' <부록 3 A 참고></p> <p>There is a summary table about posts. Do you see the blank spaces in the table? Yes.</p> <p>Now, read the posts again quickly. And find the right words and fill in the blanks to complete the table. You have five minutes. Let's start!</p> <p>Are you all done? Let's check together! First, in Han's post, 'Freezing Mongolia'. He wears a thick traditional coat. Why? Right! To adapt to the harsh climate. Good! Second, they built tents to let the strong wind pass easily.</p>	<p>PPT Worksheet</p>	

	<p>What shape was the tent? Yes. A round tent! Great job, everyone!</p>		
<p>After You Read B (Let's Write)</p>	<p>Now, It's 'Let's write'. <부록 3 B 참고> We read our friends' posts. Now, it is our turn. Let's write a post. What did our friends write about? Right. They wrote about their climate. So, let's write about Korea's climate.</p> <p>Yuri, What is special about Korea's climate? Right. Korea has four seasons. And Summer and winter are very clear. Good job.</p> <p>Look at the screen. Here is an example post. You just fill in the blanks.</p> <p>Yuri said Korea has strong summer and winter. So, write about how we live in summer and winter. Do you understand?</p> <p>Look at the right side. There is a word box. It has many useful words. There are action words like 'eat' or 'use'. And There are also season words like For summer? Yes, <i>Samgyetang</i> and bamboo pillows <i>Jukbuin</i>. For winter? Warm snacks like <i>Bungeoppang</i>, <i>Kimjang</i>, and the heating system, <i>Ondol</i>. You can use these words or you can use your own words.</p> <p>But here is one rule. What have we been learning? Right. Actions from the past to now.</p>	<p>PPT Worksheet</p>	

	<p>You have to use that form. Use it in the blanks. Do you understand?</p> <p>Okay. You have five minutes. If you need some help, call me. Let's start!</p>
