

DECLARATION OF CHRISTOPHER KIM

I, Christopher (Kyung Joon) Kim, declare and state as follows,

1. I have personal knowledge of the facts hereinafter stated, and if called upon to testify, I could and would competently testify thereto.

2. I am a judgment debtor in this case, *Optional Capital, Inc. v. Kim*, CV No. 04-3866-ABC (PLAx). I also am the principal and Chief Executive Offices for judgment debtor Alexandria Investment, LLC ("Alexandria"). I currently am incarcerated in prison in South Korea.

3. I received the Court's September 28, 2011 order from my attorney.

4. Since I am the person most knowledgeable regarding Alexandria's property and debts, I am the most appropriate person to appear at Alexandria's judgment debtor exam. However, due to my incarceration I cannot personally appear at an exam in Los Angeles.

5. Nevertheless, since both the Plaintiff Optional Capital, Inc., a Korean corporation, and I are physically located here in South Korea, I will agree to appear at a judgment debtor examination to be held at my prison at a date and time ordered by this Court. I believe Optional has attorneys in Korea and is able to have Korean counsel question me here regarding Alexandria's property and debts.

6. I also have sent letters to at least five individuals asking whether they would agree to be designated and appear at an L.A. exam. I have not heard from

them yet, but will notify my attorney as soon as I do as to whether any of them have agreed.

I declare under penalty under the laws of the United States that the foregoing is true and correct. Executed on October 18, 2011, at Cheon-an City, South Korea.
