1. ENTIRE TEXT.

2. SUMMARY: WE HAVE SPOKEN TO A NUMBER OF POLITICALLY-AWARE AGREANS SINCE PRESIDENT PARK'S DEATH. MOST OF THESE PEOPLE ARE OPPOSITION POLITICIANS OR DISSIDENTS BUT SOME ARE PRO-GOVERNMENT. THEIR VIEWS DO NOT NECESSARILY REFLECT POPULAR OPINION. THE FEELING IS STRONG IN THIS OPPOSITION-ORIENTED GROUP THAT PRESIDENT PARK'S DEATH WAS THE RESULT OF A COUP ATTEMPT, ONE IN WHICH THE AMERICANS MAY HAVE BEEN INVOLVED. PEOPLE THINK THAT THE MILITARY, HAVING ACPIEVED POWER, WILL NOT GIVE IT UP EASILY. OUR SAMPLING OF PRO-GOVERNMENT POLITICIANS SUGGESTS THEY ARE DRIFTING WITHOUT THEIR LEADER, BUT SOME ARE CLEARLY WILLING, OR EVEN EAGER, TO SEE SOME SORT OF SUBSTANTIAL MOVEMENT TOWARD A MORE DEMOCRATIC GOVERNMENT. SEEMS MUCH MORE CONFIDENT OF THE FUTURE THAN THE PROGOVERNMENT PARTIES, ALTHOUGH THEY FEEL THAT PROLONGATION OF MILITARY CONTROL COULD RUIN THEIR PLANS FOR DEMOCRATIZATION. EVERYONE BELIEVES THAT U.S. POWER TO SHAPE EVENTS IS THE GREATEST IN YEARS, AND OPPOSITION FIGURES SAY WE WOULD BE FOOLS NOT TO USE THAT POWER TO ER KOREAN DEMOCRACY. SUB-SURFACE POLITICAL ACTIVITY IS HIGH AND WILL PICK UP AFTER THE PRESIDENT'S FUNERAL. MUCH OF THE VENOM DIRECTED AT PARK AS A PERSON IS GONE. KIM YONG-SAM

SEEMS DETERMINED TO PRESS FOR QUICK, MAXIMUM GAINS, BUT EVEN SOME OF HIS PARTY COLLEAGUES SEE HIS INFLEXIBILITY AS AN OBSTACLE TO MOVEMENT TOWARD DEMOCRACY. NO MATTER WHAT DEVELOPS, STATEMENTS AND ACTIONS OF THE U.S. ARE GOING TO BE SEEN AS TREMENDOUSLY SIGNIFICANT BY THE KOREANS AND MOST WILL GIVE US A LARGE SHARE OF THE CREDIT OR BLAME FOR THE EVENTUAL OUTCOME. END SUMMARY.

3. SINCE PRESIDENT PARK'S DEATH, WE HAVE SPOKEN TO A NUMBER OF POLITICALLY-AWARE KOREANS ABOUT THE EVENTS LEADING UP TO HIS KILLING AND PROSPECTS FOR THE FUTURE. MOST OF THESE CONTACTS WERE AMONG THE OPPOSITION AND DISSIDENT ELEMENTS, ALTHOUGH SOME PRO-GOVERNMENT POLITI-CIANS MERE INCLUDED. THEIR OPINIONS DO NOT NECESSARILY REFLECT THE FEELING OF THE AVERAGE KOREAN. AMONG THE OPPOSITIONISTS THERE IS CONCERN THAT PRESIDENT PARK'S DEATH WA'S THE RESULT OF A KCIA OR MILITARY COUP PLOT. WHILE RUMORS ABOUT THE PRESIDENT/S DEATH EXISTED FROM THE VERY FIRST, A NUMBER OF CIRCUMSTANCES (GENERAL CHUNG SUNG-HWAYS PRESENCE IN THE AREA, THE ROLE OF KIM KYE-WON. AND DEBATE ABOUT WHO DID THE ACTUAL SHOOTING OF THE PRESI-DENT) HAVE LED TO A CONVICTION BY MANY POLITICALLY-AWARE KOREANS WE HAVE TALKED WITH THAT THE PRESIDENT'S DEATH WAS FAR MORE THAN A BIZARRE INCIDENT IN WHICH ONLY KIM

CHAE-RYU AND HIS HENCHMEN WERE INVOLVED. THESE SAME PEOPLE ALSO TEND TO ASSUME THAT THE U.S. PLAYED A ROLE IN THE PRESIDENT'S DEATH, OR AT LEAST GAVE TACIT APPROVAL FOR THE SHOOTING. ACCORDING TO THE PEOPLE WHO VOICE THESE SUSPICIONS, THE ROK MILITARY, HAVING BEEN THRUST INTO POWER A MAY WELL DECIDE NOT TO RELINQUISH IT.

600 to 4. PRO-GOVERNMENT POLITICIANS, DEPRIVED OF THEIR LEADER, ARE CLEARLY LOSS AS TO WHAT TO DO. THE SHOCK THEY FEEL, COMBINED WITH THE ABSENCE OF ANYONE ABLE TO GIVE THEM ORDERS, HAS LEFT THEM DRIFTING. "BOTH CHA CHI-CHOL" AND KIM CHAE-KYU USED TO ORDER US AROUND\*, SAID ONE DRP ASSEMBLYMAN, "NOW THEY, AND THE PRESIDENT, ARE GONE." THERE IS SYMPATHY AMONG PRO-GOVERNMENT POLITICIANS FOR MANY OF THE REFORMS ADVOCATED BY THEIR OPPOSITION COLLEAGUES. FOR EXAMPLE, ONE YOUNG YUJONGHOE ASSEMBLYMAN TOLD US THAT MANY OF HIS FELLOW PARTY MEMBERS FAVOR DIRECT PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS. THE LIFTING OF EM-9 AND SIMILAR DEMOCRATIC REFORMS. ALTHOUGH SOME SORT OF TRANSITIONAL PERIOD IS NEEDED BEFORE THESE REFORMS COULD BE REALIZED. HE, LIKE NDP ASSEMBLYMAN YI CHOL-SUNG AND KO HUNG-MUN, SAID THAT PEOPLE WOULD ACCEPT A TRANSITIONAL PERIOD IF IT WERE MADE CLEAR THAT PRESIDENTIAL ELECTIONS WOULD FOLLOW. ACTING PRESIDENT CH'OE KYU-HA'S NAME IS MOST OFTEN MENTIONED AS A POSSIBLE LEADER DURING THIS PERIOD, BUT WE HAVE ALSO HEARD THAT CHUNG IL-KWON COULD PERFORM





SUCH A ROLE EFFECTIVELY AND MIGHT ACCEPT THE POST ON THAT BASIS.


