I can stay for up to 90 days in the Schengen area without a visa.

I know that a travel medical insurance is necessary to get a visa for the Schengen countries.

But citizens of the Republic of Korea don't need a visa for a few weeks trip in this area.

In this case, when I enter your country,
does a travel medical insurance have to be presented
at border crossing points of your country?

Or is a valid passport enough to be presented?
