What is Dogtail?

- Automated test framework for GUI Applications
- Uses Rich data from the GTK+ accessibility layer
- A way of driving the GUI from the Script
- Written in Python

Why do I need Dogtail?

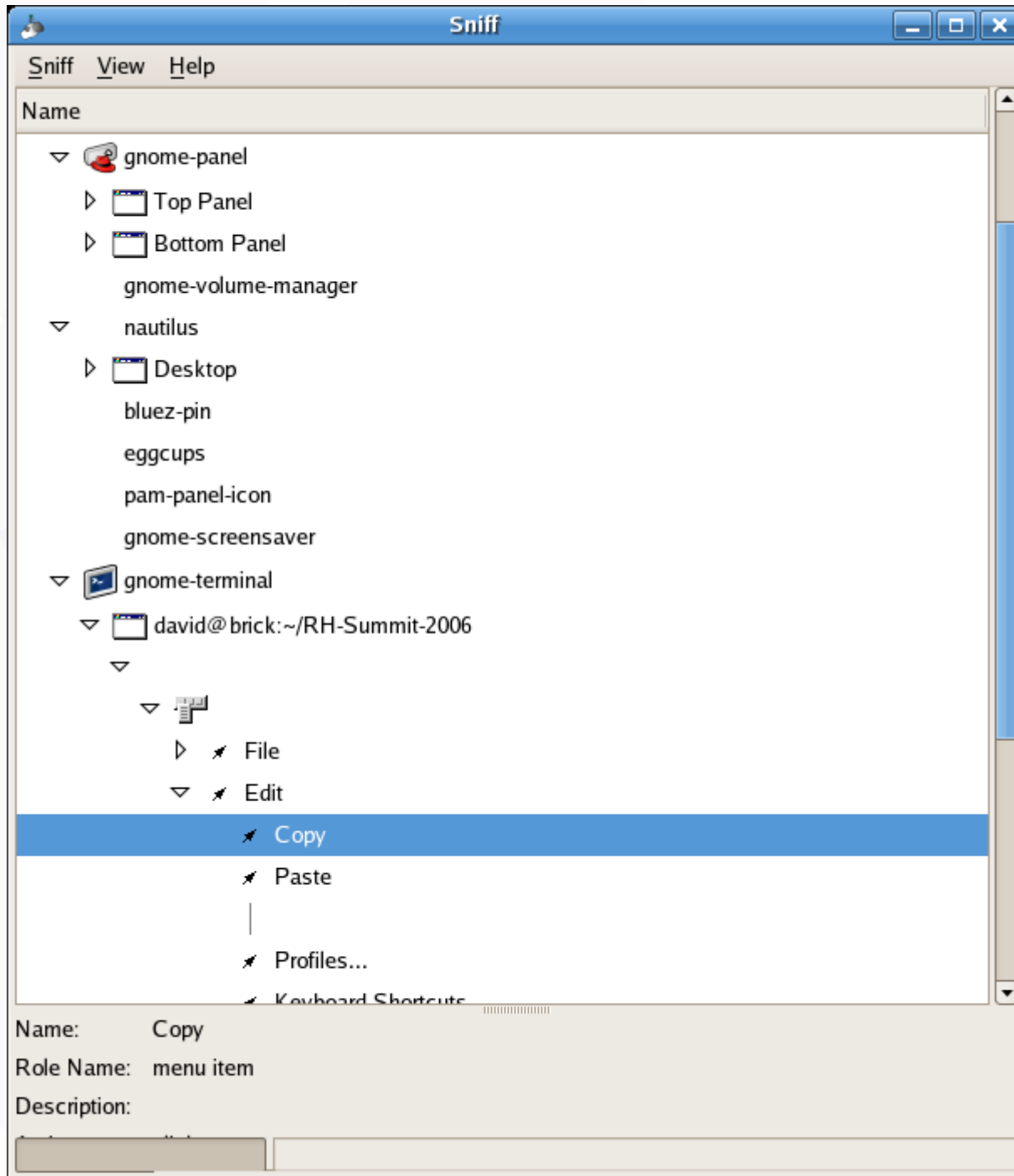
- Test Driven Development for Linux Desktop
- On a Typical Linux desktop Application... supporting more architectures... faster release cycle....makes it one of the fastest changing desktop environments
- Query based (Find me the “File” menu and the “Open” menu below it)
- It uses Accessibility (A11Y) technology to communicate with the Desktop
- Its an opensource Project from Red Hat.

What's wrong with most UI Automation tools?

- Fragility
 - Embed hardcoded (x,y) coordinates
 - “App maps”
- Vendor lock-in
 - Custom scripting languages
 - expensive/proprietary

The Dogtail APIs

- The Accessibility API
- The Procedural API



A dogtail script looks like...

```
#!/usr/bin/env python
from dogtail.tree import root

evo = root.application('evolution-2.6')
while True:
    for c in ['Mail', 'Contacts',
              'Calendars', 'Tasks']:
        submenu = evo.menu('View').menu('Window')
        submenu.menuItem(c).click()
```


Using Dogtail:: Step by Step

- Install Dogtail
- Set up the Accessibility
- Identify the GUI elements in your application.
 - The “\$n iff”util ity
 - Directly call the introspection methods
- Write and run your test scripts

Dogtail Modules

- The Core Framework
- The Helper Libraries

Coming soon in Dogtail...

- A recording and playback mechanism, GUI automation features such as logging, screen capture and analysis. (prototype available)
- Web support -AJAX te sting.
