The final composition of the team shall be declared by the team leader no later than 30 minutes before the start of the Team Pursuit competition. All skaters in the team must wear the national team racing suits of the ISU Member concerned.

The composition of Division A and B, the drawing of pairs and the composition of quartets will be made according to ISU Communication No. 1465, paragraph 6.

For each distance World Cup points and prize money will be awarded according to ISU Communication No. 1465, paragraphs 7 and 9.
