On behalf of The Norwegian Skating Association and the Organising Committee we have the honour and pleasure to invite you to a competition in the 2007/2008 ESSENT ISU WORLD CUP SPEED SKATING to be held at the Hamar Olympic Hall Hamar, Norway on Friday, January 25 – Sunday, January 27, 2008 The competition will be held under the 2006 ISU General Regulations and Special Regulations/Technical Rules for Speed Skating and ISU Communication No. 1465.

* The start time for these races are subject to change and will be announced at the Draw meetings. For each distance, the races of Division A and the races of Division B are considered as two separate competitions with

independent final classifications (list of results). For Division B, the 5000m Ladies and the 10000m Men will be skated in quartets.

Track

The Hamar Olympic Hall is a fully enclosed speed skating facility with a standard speed skating track of 400 meters to the lap. The width of each lane is 4 meters with an inside training lane of 4 meters wide. The radii of the inner and outer competition lanes are 25,5 and 29,5 meters respectively.

Training Times

Hamar Olympic Hall will be open for training for entered competitors from Monday, January 21, 2008. Trial starts will be held during the ice sessions on Thursday, January 24, 2008. Only accredited competitors, substitutes and team officials will be allowed to enter the ice rink during the official training hours.

Entries

Entries must be made according to ISU Communication No. 1465. Preliminary entries, giving the number of competitors, substitutes and team officials (with provisional names), must be communicated by **Monday**, **December 31**, **2007**. Final entries, with the names of the competitors and substitutes and the distances to be skated, as well as the names of team officials, must be communicated no later than **Tuesday**, **January 22**, **2008**.

All other Members may enter a maximum of 2 competitors in each distance. Entered skaters must have achieved qualifying times for the respective distances, as stated in ISU Communication No. 1465.

Citizenship/Residence Requirements and Clearance Procedure

In accordance with Rule 109 of the ISU Regulations and ISU Communication No. 1420, all skaters who do not have the nationality of the Member by which they have been entered or who, although having such nationality, have in the past represented another Member, must produce an ISU Clearance Certificate.

Grouping and Drawing Procedure

For each individual distance, the entered skaters compete in two separate divisions with the currently best ranked skaters competing in Division A; the remaining skaters in Division B. "Wild card" requests for Division A should be made when the skater is entered, and must be confirmed at the team leaders' meeting. For each division, the composition of pairs and the sequence of pairs will be determined according to the current World Cup ranking, in accordance with ISU Communication No. 1465.

Prizes and Points

For each distance World Cup points and prize money will be awarded according to ISU Communication No. 1465.

Anti-Doping Control

Anti-Doping tests will be carried out in accordance with the valid ISU Anti-Doping Code (ISU Communications Nos. 1447 & 1448 or any further update of these Communications).

Liability

In accordance with Rule 119, the ISU, The Norwegian Skating Association, The Organising Committee and Hamar Olympic Hall assume no responsibility for liability with respect to bodily or personal injury or loss of property or damage incurred in connection with the Essent ISU World Cup Speed Skating competition. Each Member is solely responsible for providing insurance coverage thereto.

Board and Lodging

The Organizing Committee is responsible for board and lodging at the official hotels for up to 5 competitors and 1 team leader from each Member (to a maximum of 4 rooms based on double occupancy) beginning with dinner on Thursday, January 24 until breakfast on the morning of Monday, January 28, in accordance with ISU Communication No. 1465, paragraph 11. Additional expenses for rooms and meals will be borne by each Member.

Due to the large number of expected participants, the Organizing Committee reserves the right to limit the number of hotel rooms available to each team at the official hotels. The organizer is not obliged to provide services (accommodation, accredited entrance to the ice rink, transportation, etc.) for an excessive number of team officials or other accompanying persons from participating ISU Members. Names and functions of all team officials must be submitted together with the final entries for the competition, in accordance with ISU Communication No. 1465, paragraph 11.

Official Hotels

The Organizing Committee will arrange hotel reservations for the participants at the official hotels. Room requirements must be received as soon as possible, but no later than **Monday, December 31, 2007**.
