[Aladdin]

Hey, that's the last thing I wanna be. Okay, I'm gonna go see her. I just ... I g ...
I gotta be smooth. Cool! Confident! How do I look?

[Genie]

Like prince

[Aladdin]

Princess Jasmin?

[Jasmin]

Who's there?

[Aladdin]

It's me. Prince Ali. Uh— Prince Ali Ababwa.

[Jasmin]

I do not want to see you.

[Aladdin]

No, no, no Please Princess. G— Give me a chance

[Jasmin]

Just leave me alone.

[Aladdin]

Down, down kitty

[Genie]

So how's our little beau doing?

[Carpet]

Look a mouse, Scat!

[Aladdin]

Come on kitty! Take of back down kitty

[Jasmin]

W—Wait wait? Do I know you?

[Aladdin]

Oh! no! no!

[Jasmin]

You remind me of someone I met in the marketplace.

[Aladdin]

The market place? I have servant who go to the marketplace for me. Why, I—I even have servants who go to the marketplace for my servants. So it it couldn't have been me you meet.

[Jasmin]

No I guess not.

[Genie]

Enough about you Casanova. Talk about her.

[Aladdin]

Huh?

[Genie]

[Aladdin]

Punctual!

[Jasmin]

Uh uh, beautiful.

[Genie]

Nice recovery

[Jasmin]

I'm reach too, you know.

[Aladdin]

Yeah

[Jasmin]

The daughter of the Sultan

[Aladdin]

I know.

[Jasmin]

A fine prize for any place to marry.

[Aladdin]

Oh right right. A prince like me.

[Genie]

Warning! Warning!

[Jasmin]

Right, A prince like you. And every other stuffed shirts

[Aladdin]

Hey wait!

[Jasmin]

Swaggering peacock I've meet!

[Genie]

Mayday! mayday!

[Jasmin]

Just go jump off a balcony!

[Aladdin]

What? wha--

[Genie]

Stop her! Stop her! Want me to sting her?

[Aladdin]

Buzz off!

[Genie]

Okay fine. But remember be yourself!

[Aladdin]
Your right.

[Jasmin]
What?

[Aladdin]
Uh, uh, your right. You aren't just some prize to be won. You should be free to make your own choice. I'll go now!

[Jasmin]
No!

[Aladdin]
What? What?

[Jasmin]
How? How are you doing that?

[Aladdin]
A magic carpet.

[Jasmin]
It's lovely.

[Aladdin]
You, uh, you don't want to go for a ride, do you? We could get out of the place see the world.

[Jasmin]
Is it safe?

[Aladdin]
Sure, do you trust me?

[Jasmin]
What?

[Aladdin]

[Jasmine]

Prince Ali!

[Iago]

How in the... Awk!

[Aladdin]

Tell them the truth, Jafar! You tried to have me killed!

[Jafar]

What ridiculous nonsense, your highness. He's obviously lying.

[King]

Obviously lying.

[Jasmine]

Father, What's wrong with you?

[Aladdin]

I know what's wrong! Your highness! Jafar has been controlling you with this!

[King]

What, Jafar! You low traitor!

[Jafar]

Your majesty! All this can be explained!

[King]

Guards! Guards!

[Iago]

Well, that's it! we've dead! Just dig a grave for both of us. We're dead!

[King]

Arrest Jafar at once!

[Jafar]

This is not done yet, boy!

[King]

Find him! Search everywhere!

[Aladdin]

Jasmine, are you all right?

[Jasmine]

Oh, yes.

[King]

Jafar! My most trusted counselor. Plotting against me all this time. This is horrible, just horrible. How will I ever... Can this be true? My daughter has findly

chosen a suitor. Praise Allah! You brilliant boy! I could kiss you. I won't..... I leave that to my..... But you two will be wed at once! Yes, Yes! You'll be happy and prosperous. And then you, my boy, will become Sultan.

[King]

[Genie]

[Genie]

[Iago in Jafar's voice]

Excellent work, Iago.

[Iago]

Ah, go on.

[Iago in Jafar's voice]

No, really on the scale of one to ten. you are an eleven!

[Iago]

Oh, Jafar, you too kind! I'm embarrassed, I'm blushing!

[King]

People of Agrabah, my daughter has finally chosen her suitor!

[Aladdin]

Jasmine?

[Jasmine]

Al, where have you been?

[Aladdin]

Jasmine, there's something I got to tell you.

[Jasmine]

The whole kingdom has turned out for father's announcement.

[Aladdin]

No, but Jasmine, listen, please.

[Jasmine]

Good luck!

[King]

Prince Ali Abuabwa.

[Aladdin]

Oh, boy.

[Iago]

Now look at them. Cheering that little pipsqueak!

[Jafar]

Let them cheer.

[Genie]

No, Al, I'm getting really... I don't think you're him. Tonight the part of Al will be played by a tall dark and sinister ugly man.

[Jafar]

I'm your master now.

[Genie]
I'm afraid of that.

[Jafar]
Grand me my first wish. I wish to rule on high as Sultan!

[King]
Whoa! Bless my soul, What is this? What ... What is going on? I... oh! my goodness, What's happening?

[Jasmine]
Father!

[King]
Jafar, you vile betrayer!

[Iago]
That's Sultan vile betrayer to you!

[Aladdin]
Oh, yeah? We'll just see about that! The lamp!

[Jafar]
Finders, keepers, Abooboo.

[Aladdin]
Genie, No!

[Genie]
Sorry, kid. I got a new master now.

[King]
Jafar, I order you to stop!

[Jafar]
But there's a new order now. My order! Finally you will bow to me!

[Jasmine]
We will never bow to you!

[Iago]
Why am I not surprised?

[Jafar]

If you won't bow before a Sultan, then you will cower before a sorcerer! Genie , my second wish. I wish to be the most powerful sorcerer in the world!

[Aladdin]

[Iago]

[Jasmin]

Ali what ...

[Aladdin]

[Jafar]

[Jasmine]

You're tall, dark, well-dressed.

[Genie]

[Aladdin]

Hey, I'm a street rat, remember. I'll improvise.

[Jafar]

Go on.

[Jasmine]

And your beard is so twisted. You've stolen my heart.

[Iago]

Jaf--!

[Jafar]

And the street rat?

[Jasmine]

What street rat?

[Jafar]

That was You! How many times do I have to kill you, boy!

[Jasmin]

No

[Aladdin]

Get the lamp!

[Jafar]

No, princess! Your time is up!

[Aladdin]

Jasmine!

[Iago]

Oh, nice shot, Jafar!

[Jafar]

Don't toy with me!

[Aladdin]

Abu!

[Jafar]

Things are unraveling fast now, boy! Get the point? I'm just getting warned up!

[Aladdin]

Are you afraid to fight me yourself, you cowardly snake?

[Jafar]

A snake am I? Perhaps you'd like to see how snakelike I can be.

[Genie]

Ricken, racken, rocken, rake! Stick that sword into that snake!

[Jafar]

You stay out of this!

[Genie]

Jafar, Jafar, he's our man. If he can't do it, GREAT!

[Jasmine]

Aladdin!

[Jafar]

[Iago]

[Jafar]

[Aladdin]

[Jafar]

[Genie]

[Aladdin]

[Jafar]

[Aladdin]

[Iago]

Come on. You're the Genie! I don't...

[Aladdin]

I tty bitty living space.
