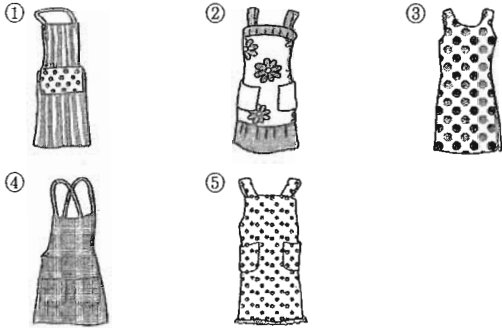

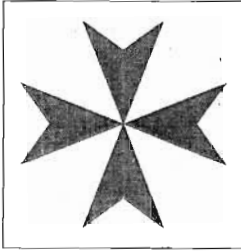

The eight points are said to symbolize the eight points of courage. In some countries, the Maltese cross forms the basis for the design of a Fire Fighter's badge of honor. The axe and helmet in the ④ center of the badge represent some equipment used in the fire service, and the outer ladder on the ⑤ right means protection from death.

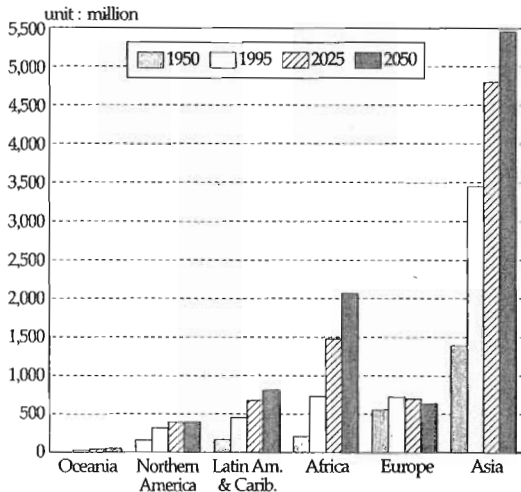
